Sheriff's Report Notes:

1. Deputy Brandon Sims 301 gave me his 2-week notice. His last day is January 14, 2023. He was hired by Panhandle Police Department.
2. Dispatcher Kaylee Leach gave me her 2-week notice. Her last day is January 14, 2023. She is moving to Tennessee.
3. Dispatcher Alyssa Otto gave me her 2-week notice. Her last day is January 11, 2023. She is moving to Tennessee with Kaylee.
4. I have had 3 inquiries into the open deputy position, and I have had 5 inquiries into the open dispatch positions. I am attempting to find coverage or a backup plan for dispatch until I have 2 hired. Until then, I will be filling in where I can.
5. There have been 5 people arrested in December resulting from warrants found during routine traffic stops (by both Armstrong County deputies and DPS Troopers).
