Currently working on and designing a training program for election workers, by job. The SOS provides training on their website, however this just covers scenarios of how to check voters in and the what is required to verify a voter. The training I am working will cover how to use the equipment, and paperwork they must fill out for each election.

Created a spreadsheet that has the total number of in person Voters for the Extended hours of the Primary Election (March 5, 2024), and the Primary Runoff (May 28th, 2024) and submitted to Andrea Wilson of Llano County to present to the Legislators this next session. All EA and Clerks of small counties are trying to show that the mandatory extended hours for small counties is not cost effective.
