Notice of Public Hearing

The Armstrong County Commissioners' Court will conduct a public hearing at its next regularly scheduled meeting on Tuesday, October 14, 2025, at 9:00 a.m. to consider an amendment to a tax abatement agreement with Crusoe Energy Systems, LLC. A tax abatement agreement with Crusoe Energy Systems, LLC was previously approved by the Armstrong County Commissioners Court on November 12, 2024. As provided in the original agreement, Crusoe Energy Systems, LLC and/or its affiliates will construct and equip data center-related facilities in the amended Reinvestment Zone #8, generally south of Claude in the vicinity of Lima Road, east of State Highway 207. The estimated cost of the improvements and associated personal property will be at least one billion dollars per phase with up to eight phases possible. In determining whether to grant the amendment to the abatement agreement, the Commissioners' Court will consider whether such would contribute to the retention or expansion of primary employment or would contribute to the economic development of the County. All those interested may appear and present testimony regarding the amendment.
